TENNESSEE FOREIGN LANGUAGE INSTITUTE RASMUSSEN SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM

Guidelines

1. Applicant must be Tennessee resident.
2. Only one application may be accepted per family per semester.
3. All information received, whether personal or financial, will be kept in strict confidence. It will only be shared with the committee, the executive director, and the deputy director.
4. All applications and requested documents are to be submitted by the deadline to the Rasmussen Scholarship Award Program Committee, Tennessee Foreign Language Institute, 227 French Landing, Suite 100, Nashville, TN 37228
5. If the applicant has to cancel a registration, the scholarship money will not be applied to the next semester at the Institute, however, the applicant may reapply.
6. Applicants chosen to participate in the program will be required to cover the cost of the materials (textbooks and other supplemental materials) and the remaining cost of the tuition.
7. Up to three scholarships may be awarded per applicant per academic year, each under separate application.

Criteria

In awarding the Rasmussen Scholarship, the Program Committee will take the following factors into consideration:

1. Total amount of tuition and materials charges.
2. Family size, income, and financial circumstances.
3. Commitment to the study of choice at the Tennessee Foreign Language Institute.
