

## Supply List for Snowman Kitchen Crochet

### Project 1: Snowman Kitchen Towel

**Pattern:**

Snowman Kitchen Towel from A Crocheted Simplicity

**Hooks:**

J/10 (6.00mm), H/8 (5.00mm) and G/6 (4.00mm) hooks, or hook needed to obtain gauge (I recommend a Boye aluminum crochet hook, but you can also use bamboo and wooden hooks if you prefer.)

**Yarn:**

- 140 yards of white worsted weight cotton yarn
- 8 yards of black worsted weight cotton yarn
- 3 yards of red worsted weight cotton yarn
- 1 yard of orange worsted weight cotton yarn
- 1 yard of dark green worsted weight yarn

Suggested Yarns:

*Lily Sugar N' Cream*

*Big Twist Cotton Yarn*

*Lion Brand 24/7 Cotton Yarn*

*Premier Yarns Home Cotton*

*Bernat Handicrafter Cotton Solids Yarn*

\*When possible, I suggest using all of the same of one type of yarn so it has a uniform feel (i.e. if you use Lily Sugar N' Cream, buy all your colors in Lily Sugar N' Cream)

### Project 2: Snowman Belly Pot Holder

**Hook:**

1/9 (5.50mm) hook, or hook needed to obtain gauge (I recommend a Boye aluminum crochet hook, but you can also use bamboo and wooden hooks if you prefer.)

**Yarn:**

- 100g of white worsted weight cotton yarn
- 30g of red worsted weight cotton yarn (or color of choice for scarf)
- scraps of black worsted weight cotton yarn

*Lion Brand 24/7 Cotton Yarn*

*Premier Yarns Home Cotton*

*Bernat Handicrafter Cotton Solids Yarn*
